a. Description of Fee: In order to continue to provide an acceptable level of fire protection to the citizens of the District, funding for additional fire station, equipment, and related facilities must be provided. Section 66000 of the California Government Code authorizes cities and counties to establish impact fees, on behalf of fire districts, on new construction, to finance facilities and equipment made necessary by new development. The City fee is an impact fee imposed upon new development.
